As Barbara and I proposed, we would like to purchase the story idea, "Buster and Babs Go Hawaiian," co-written by Renee, for production as an animated cartoon for the TINY TOON ADVENTURES television series. Our standard story premise purchase price is \$250.00 (which, in this case, would be split three ways).

In order to continue your daughter's direct involvement in the production process of this episode, we would also like to offer you, your husband and Renee, an all-expenses paid trip to Los Angeles. As the production of this episode continues, we may ask your daughter to review voice-tracks and storyboards, and to participate in the final viewing of the finished product (details to be determined).


